ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION:-

- Good academic record with at least 55% of the marks or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O,A,B,C,D,E and F at the Master's degree level, in the relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from a foreign University. Candidates must have respective basic professional degree at undergraduate lavel.
- ii. For the candidates having Master's Degree, NET shall remain compulsory alongwith one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated referred journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the discipline in which NET is conducted.

Essentiality of NET can be waived off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations, 2009 and the candidate has at least two full length publications having a NAAS rating not less than 4, on the last date of submission of application.

Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.

Note:-

The University reserves the right not to fill-up the post even after selection. No correspondences will be entertained in this regard. Fee once deposited shall not be refunded in any circumstances. In no case application received after closing date will be considered. The application form duly forwarded by parent office must reach this office within a fortnight after closing date, in case of in-service candidates; however, they must submit an advance copy with requisite fee within stipulated time.

MAXIMUM AGE LIMIT:-

- i. Maximum age as per Resolution No. 294 dated 07.01.2016 issued by General Administration Department, Govt. of Bihar, Patna is as follows:
 - a) Unreserved Category (Male) 37 Yrs.
 - b) Backward Class and Extremely Backward Class (Male & Female) 40 Yrs.
 - c) Unreserved Category (Female) 40 Yrs.
 - d) Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Male & Female) 42 Yrs.
- ii. Those candidates who will apply first time, their maximum age limit will be determined on the last date i.e. 28.03.2023.
- iii. Those candidates who have applied earlier in Advt. No. 05/2021 dated 23.08.2021, their maximum age limit will be determined as the cut-off date advertised vide the Advt. No. 05/2021 dated 23.08.2021.
- iv. There will be no age restriction for employees of Bihar Agricultural University, Sabour seeking higher posts under direct recruitment procedures.

RESERVATION:-

- i. Reservation shall only be applicable to the original resident of Bihar State. Horizontal Reservations to Divyang / Grandchild to freedom fighter, shall be applicable as per Guidelines of Govt. of Bihar.
- ii. Candidates seeking employment against reserved vacancies must submit respective caste/category certificate issued by the competent authority as per the rules. Physically handicapped persons (Divyang) must submit the certificate of disability issued by the competent authority.
- iii. As per Circular No. 11/आ०नी०-I-11/2015 साठप्राठ 2342 dated 15.02.2016 in case of unavailability of female candidate (UR-F, SC-F, EBC-F, BC-F, EWS-F) post shall be filled with male candidate of same category in the same transaction.
- iv. As per notification no. 11/अग0नी0-1-03/2019 साоप्राо 2623 dated 26.02.2019 of General Administration Department, Govt. of Bihar. [The Bihar Reservation in vacancies in posts and in Services and in Admission in the Educational Institute (For Economically Weaker Sections) Rule, 2019 Clause-7], if candidate from EWS are not available to the extent of reservation percentage prescribed under Act the vacancies of this category shall be filled up by the candidates from Open Merit Category in the same transaction.

In the event of total marks obtained by two or more candidates is same, the candidate having higher cumulative marks under SI. No. 1 (Academic Qualification) of the evaluation criteria as above will be placed higher in the final merit list. Subsequently, in the event of candidate having same cumulative marks under SI. No. 1 (Academic Qualification) of the evaluation criteria, candidates who are older in age according to the date of birth will be placed higher in the final merit list and in the event of candidates having same date of birth, candidates whose name appear alphabetically first in Devnagiri Scrip will be placed higher in the final merit list.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:-

- 1. The candidates are required to apply only through **ONLINE** mode. **Application** filled-up through any other mode will **NOT** be entertained.
- 2. Before filling-up the Online Application Form, the candidates are advised to read General Instructions, Essential Qualification and Other Important Conditions carefully.
- 3. Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 4. Separate application along with application fee should be submitted for each post applied for.
- 5. The University reserves the right to:
 - a. Withdraw the advertisement either partly or wholly at any time without assigning any reason to this effect.

- 9. No interim correspondence shall be entertained.
- 10. The list of eligible candidates for interview or any other information related to date, time and venue of interview shall be uploaded on the University website i.e. www.bausabour.ac.in.
- 11. The person appointed against any post shall be governed by the act/statutes/rules and regulation of the University/ICAR as framed and amended from time to time.
- 12. The service conditions including pay level and age of superannuation shall be as per University/ICAR rules.
- 13. Information uploaded on the University website shall not be provided to the candidate under RTI Act, 2005. The uploaded information on the University website shall Page 5 of 11
